HEALTH FAIRS: Provide a vast array of educational literature, bookmarks, stickers, key chains, coloring books, posters, and more during community health fairs.

SOAPY: Teach children about the importance of handwashing in preventing the spread of germs and illnesses in local schools and after-school programs.

THE PEDOMETER PROJECT: Educate schoolchildren about good nutrition and exercise based on the success of our Worcester-based pedometer project.

SAVE: Join the American Medical Association Alliance campaign to Stop America's Violence Everywhere through local community initiatives.

ANTI-BULLYING CAMPAIGN: Work with school nurses to distribute literature about bullying and prevent school violence.

SCREEN OUT: Become active in a national American Medical Association Alliance campaign to eradicate smoking from movies in production.

HEALTH LITERACY: Educate those working in medical settings about the crisis of patients unable to read consents, prescriptions, and other medical literature.

The MMSA increases awareness of legislative issues affecting health care today through frequent online updates and alerts, advocacy training, and educational workshops.

HEALTH PROMOTION

The MMSA is actively engaged in campaigns to stop smoking, fight obesity, increase fitness, and prevent the spread of disease through our handwashing campaign featuring Soapy™ for grades kindergarten through three. Alliance members foster anti-bullying protocols both in the classroom and online, and support injury-prevention awareness through helmet safety and seatbelt legislation.
