Electronic Attendance Scanning for the House of Delegates and CME Sessions

Each attendee's badge will have a quick response, or QR, code on the reverse side. A QR code is a type of matrix barcode used on gate passes, nutrition labels, and for marketing purposes. Once scanned, your name and attendance "scan" will write to an internal MMS database accessed only by MMS staff. *The barcode contains your name and MMS ID number only*. Attendees should use this barcode to "scan-in" and record their attendance at all HOD sessions and CME events (no scanning is required at caucus breakfasts, lunches or social events).



For the <u>House of Delegates First Session</u>, MMS staff will scan your QR code <u>at the registration desk</u>.

For the Annual Oration and the Ethics Forum, YOU will scan your QR code with the help of a staff member or on your own at the kiosks located at the entrance of the CME event. Tap the screen to select the CME event(s) you plan to attend. The event will turn green to signify that you are checked in.

For the <u>House of Delegates Second Session</u>, you will scan your QR code with the help of a staff member or on your own at the kiosks located at the entrance of the HOD. Tap the screen to select the HOD event you plan to attend. The event will turn **green** to signify that you are checked in. **On Saturday, there is no need to physically check-in at the registration desk.**

Please keep and wear your badge for the entire meeting.
