

Bootcamp: Update on GI Malpractice and Navigating Employment Models

Program Description

The Massachusetts Gastroenterology Association (MGA) Endoscopic Education Program Committee has been formed with the mission of providing practical, evidence-based lectures and seminars to practicing New England gastroenterologists and GI fellows who may not have the opportunity to attend more distant and extended national conferences. This lecture series covers a broad range of topics in endoscopy, hepatology, and gastroenterology.

National and regional malpractice claims data can be difficult to obtain and interpret. In addition, published data may not be applicable to an individual's practice setting or region. Therefore, an update in the current understanding of medical malpractice is necessary to maintain current knowledge and competence gastroenterology practice. GI fellowship training focuses on acquiring endoscopic and clinical skills, but does not often address the career search process. In this conference, we will present several employment models for gastroenterology.

1. Evaluate regional malpractice data in the context of their own practice setting
2. Identify common themes in claims in a case-based setting
3. Understand the different employment models for gastroenterology

FROM BOSTON

Travel west on the Massachusetts Turnpike/I-90 to Exit 15. Keep right beyond the tollbooth and follow the signs for I-95/128 North. Follow 95/128 North for approximately two miles to Exit 27A-27B (Winter Street). Off exit ramp, keep right and go over 128 and follow Winter Street for approximately one mile. You'll pass the reservoir on your right, and the road will curve sharply to the right. Immediately after the curve, you'll see the Waltham Woods sign on the left. See below for further directions.

FROM POINTS WEST

Travel east on the Massachusetts Turnpike/I-90 to Exit 14. Keep left beyond the tollbooth and follow the signs for I-95/128 North. Follow 95/128 North for approximately two miles to Exit 27A-27B (Winter Street). Off exit ramp, keep right and go over 128 and follow Winter Street for approximately one mile. You'll pass the reservoir on your right, and the road will curve sharply to the right. Immediately after the curve, you'll see the Waltham Woods sign on the left. See below for further directions.

FROM POINTS NORTH

Travel south on Route 128/I-95 to Exit 27B (Winter Street). Off exit ramp, keep right and follow Winter Street for approximately one mile. You'll pass the reservoir on your right, and the road will curve sharply to the right. Immediately after the curve, you'll see the Waltham Woods sign on the left. See below for further directions.

FROM POINTS SOUTH

Travel north on Route 128/I-95 to Exit 27A-27B (Winter Street). Off exit ramp, keep right and go over 128 and follow Winter Street for approximately one mile. You'll pass the reservoir on your right, and the road will curve sharply to the right. Immediately after the curve, you'll see the Waltham Woods sign on the left. See below for further directions.

AT WALTHAM WOODS

Take a left at the Waltham Woods sign on Winter Street, and follow the road up the hill (approximately one-third mile). MMS Headquarters will be directly in front of you. (Note that parking and the main entrance are at the back of the building.)
