4. First municipality to enact: Boston effective 2/11/09; First city ordinance enacted: Newton effective 11/16/09; First town bylaw enacted: Brookline effective 4/9/12 (approved by Mass. Attorney General)
5. In Everett and West Springfield, one pharmacy is both a retailer and wholesaler. Tobacco sales are permitted to wholesale customers only, with conditions.
6. Target and Kmart: Some stores may have pharmacies but neither company sells tobacco per company policy.
7. CVS: Intends to stop all tobacco sales in their pharmacies nationwide in October of 2014.
8. 107 municipalities have not enacted this policy AND have no pharmacies within their jurisdiction.
9. 14 municipalities have not enacted this policy AND the only pharmacy is/are CVS.
10. 1 municipality has no policy AND the only pharmacy is a Target.
