Background information for CVSHealth MinuteClinic

• You will be meeting with <u>David Fairchild</u>, <u>MD</u> at 9 am on Wednesday, January 22. Dr. Bombaugh invited Dr. Fairchild to attend a PAM meeting on learning of his new role at CVS Health MinuteClinic.

- Dr. Fairchild is a professor of medicine at UMass Medical School and the Chief Medical Officer at MinuteClinic, an arm of <u>CVS Health</u>. He is also an Editor in Chief of Physicians First Watch/NEJM Journal Watch and a member of the CQMP.
- As Chief Medical Officer of MinuteClinic, he oversees population health and clinical management et al of all soon to be 1,500 Health Hub locations, currently there are about 1,200.
- MinuteClinic retail medical clinics operate inside CVS Pharmacy locations within the United States. It
 is the largest walk-in medical clinic in the United States, with over 1,100 locations in 33 states and
 the <u>District of Columbia</u>. More than 50 percent of the U.S. population now lives within 10 miles of a
 MinuteClinic.
- Plans call for MinuteClinic to open 1,500 locations by 2021 and for them to enter the chronic care management arena.
- MinuteClinic is a product line of <u>CVS health</u> which also owns pharmacy's a pharmacy benefit management company, MinuteClinics and other product lines.
- Massachusetts currently has 59 MinuteClinic locations. 420 CVS pharmacy's and 170,994 Aetna medical members.
